The International Sai Sewa Trust (ISST) is a non-profit organization dedicated to serving the community through volunteer work, spiritual guidance, and charitable initiatives. Based in Manjhanpur, Kaushambi, Uttar Pradesh, India, ISST follows the teachings and philosophy of Shirdi Sai Baba, a revered saint known for his selfless service and compassion towards all beings.

Sai Mandir was founded in the late 2010s by a small group of devotees inspired by Shirdi Sai Baba's teachings. In 2018, the International Sai Sewa Trust was established, creating a strong foundation rooted in the values and principles of Shirdi Sai Baba.

4. To bridge the gap between vulnerable communities and the legal system by facilitating legal awareness, advocacy, and access to justice;
5. To support public policy reforms and engage with government bodies in addressing key issues like child protection, gender equality, and social justice; and
6. To propagate the teachings of Shirdi Sai Baba, emphasizing his message of love, compassion, and spiritual enlightenment.

About the Event

The **SAI MAHOTSAV** and the launch of the **Social Justice Forum** on the 6th and 7th of December 2024 by the International Sai Sewa Trust mark a significant step toward empowering women, children, and marginalized communities. This two-day event, hosted in Kaushambi, Uttar Pradesh, will focus on promoting social justice, legal awareness, and inclusivity, with a special emphasis on women and child empowerment.

The **Social Justice Forum**, headquartered in Kaushambi, will be led by appointed office bearers and associate members who will design

and implement programs aimed at educating communities about their legal rights.

The forum will prioritize issues like women's rights, child protection, and gender equality, ensuring that the underserved have access to justice and opportunities for growth. It will also foster interdisciplinary collaborations with experts in social welfare, women empowerment, community programs, and legal firms, positioning Kaushambi as a center for child and women empowerment progressive initiatives.

The **SAI MAHOTSAV** will celebrate these efforts through cultural performances, workshops, Beti Bachao-Beti Padhao Program, and interactive activities that inspire unity and community participation. A grand community meal will bring together thousands of attendees, symbolizing inclusivity and solidarity. This event reflects the trust's vision of building a society rooted in equality, justice, and empowerment for women and children.
