## Day 1 – 6th December 2024:

- Cultural Performances by local schoolchildren will follow, showcasing patriotic songs, dance, and drama that reflect themes of nationalism, social values, and women's empowerment. These performances are designed to foster unity and inspire the community to work towards a more inclusive society.
- The Prize Distribution Ceremony will recognize the exceptional contributions of children, particularly those who have shown leadership in promoting social values and working for the betterment of the community. These awards will encourage youth participation in social change.

## **Day 2 – 7th December 2024:**

- The second day will feature a **Community Meal**, expected to host approximately 10,000 individuals from diverse backgrounds. The meal will symbolize inclusivity, unity, and the spirit of community, fostering bonds across different social, economic, and cultural groups.
- During the meal and throughout the event, the Social Justice Forum will engage attendees in discussions and presentations about their legal rights, available resources, and how they can access justice when needed.
